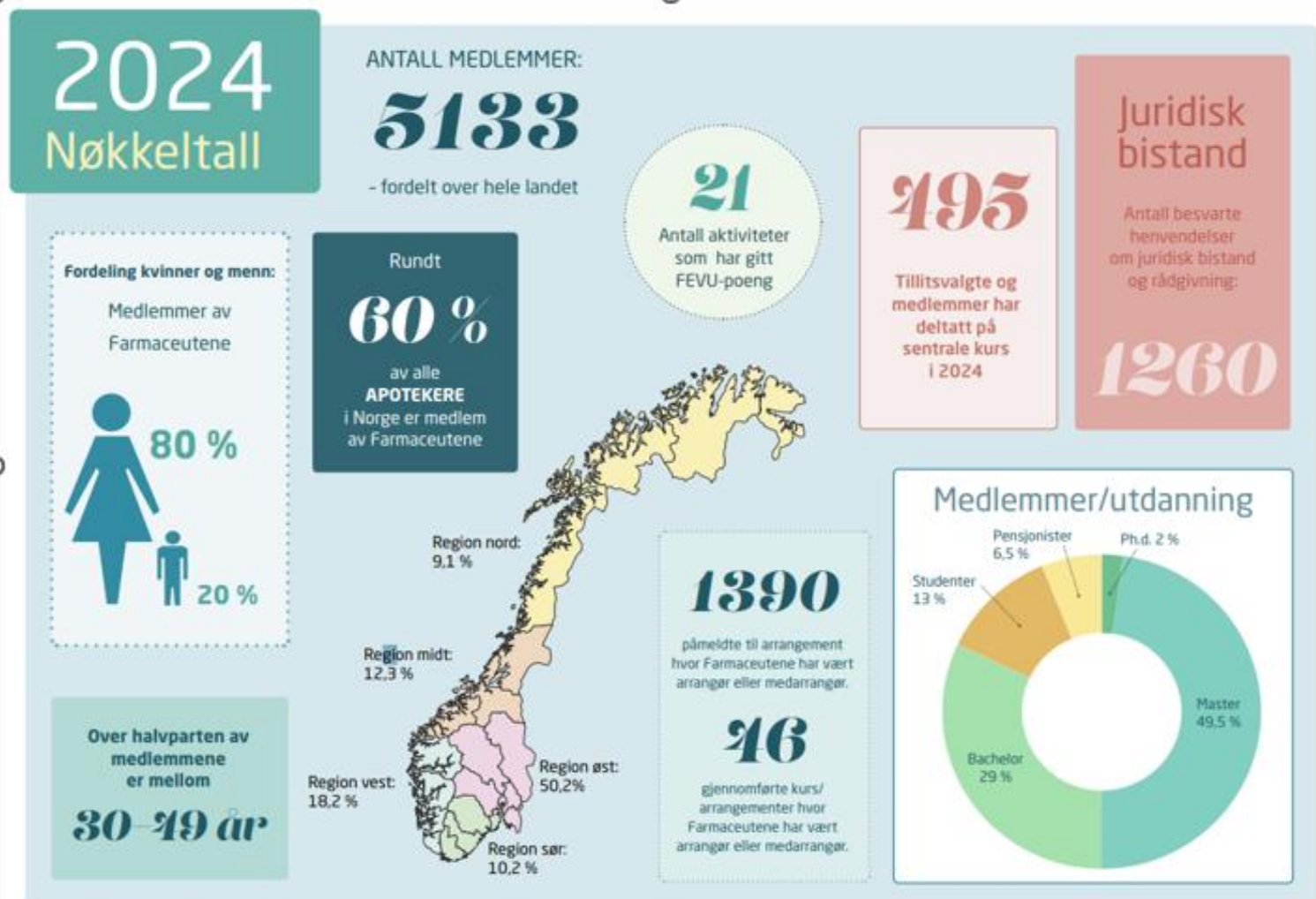
Association history and vision

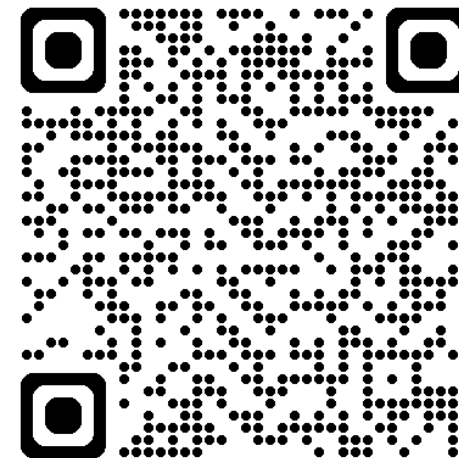
